Elements of political funding control

Reporting and disclosure aka transparency

- Income sources
- Party and campaign spending
 - Party funding oversight
- Institutional autonomy
- Institutional powers
- Resources (e.g., human, financial)

Sanctions

- Range of sanctions
- Severity of sanctions
 Implications of PFC
- PFC is the most fragile regulatory dimension
- PFC is costly and challenging to implement
- Without a robust PFC mechanism other regulations become toothless



Challenges in Implementing Political Financing Control - I

Complex Regulatory Landscape

- Diverse regulations across jurisdictions
- Difficulty in maintaining consistency and compliance
 Lack of Transparency
- Anonymous donations and shell companies
- Difficulty tracking sources and beneficiaries
 Enforcement Issues
- Limited resources for monitoring and enforcement
- Inadequate penalties for violations



Challenges in Implementing Political Financing Control - II

Technological Challenges

- Use of digital currencies and online platforms for funding
- Cybersecurity threats and data breaches

Political Resistance

- Opposition from vested interests
- Influence of powerful donors on policy-making

Public Awareness and Participation

- Low public understanding of financing rules
- Limited engagement in oversight processes



Does transparency and oversight matter?

Strength of the PFC mechanism:



Political party corruption

- *Individuals:* Do you think that the giving and taking of bribes and the abuse of power for personal gain are widespread among political parties?
- *Firms:* Which of the following practices do you consider to be the most widespread: Funding political parties in exchange for public contracts or influence over policy making

SEVERITY OF SANCTIONS


RANGE OF SANCTIONS Soft Harsh

Broad	Toothless	Robust





Putting oversight and sanctions together – strength of PFC






State of digital disclosure of campaign spending in Europe




State of digital disclosure of party annual accounts in Europe
